	Check cleanliness of playing and safety area. Remove any foreign object			\square			
\square	Check chains of sand pulleys for w ear, replace if necessary. The nominal chain thickness must not diminish more than 30% (< 3mm). Beyond that limit, a chain replacement is indispensable.			\sum			
	Check rubber parts like seats, hoses, flaps, collars (here: flag and chute of the sand pulleys) for w ear, replace if necessary			\square			
\square	Check cleanliness of sliding surfaces, remove protruding parts, exchange damaged sliding course coverings			\square			
	In case of drying cracks, remove splinters of wood and chamfer sharp edges			\square			
\square	Where appropriate, check synthetic surfacing material for damages or severe w ear, repair or replace, if necessary			\sum			
	Check tightness of stand construction: stability of (vertical) posts or supports, retighten screw connections, if necessary.						
\square	Check further structural components for wear and tightness; retighten, if necessary and replace defective parts.					\sum	
	Check bearings and/or joints for tight fixing and easy-running function, replace or grease, if necessary (here: megaphone and housing of sand pulleys).						
\square	Check tension and damages of ropes and/or nets, replace if necessary					\sum	
	Check foundations and structural construction for corrosion or decay, repair or replace if necessary						

Please note: The above-mentioned maintenance intervals only have recommendatory character. They must necessarily be adapted to the local circumstances of each playground (frequency of use, social setting, risk and frequency of vandalism etc.).
